unto the said Levi Brown his heirs and assigns the following
described lot or parcel of Land lying and being situate in the
State and County aforesaid To wit: All of the S¹/₄ of S¹/₄ of Section
Thirty five Township Two North, Range twenty eight West which
was sold to Mrs. Geo. Raymond wife of Peter Raymond, by John Thompson
as evidenced by Deed Dated August 25th 1847 except the portion of said
Land which was sold by order of the Probate Court of said County,
by Peter Raymond as Administrator of said Geo. Raymond to J. P.
Chiffon as appears of record in Book of Deeds marked D of said
County on pages 576, 577 and 578.

Together with all and singular the appurtenances and improvements
thereunto belonging to have and to hold the same unto the said
Levi Brown his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever and
we the said Joseph Strickland and Lollie Strickland his
Wife for ourselves our heirs and assigns do hereby covenant, warrant
and defend the said Levi Brown his
heirs and assigns in the title and quiet enjoyment of the
