hereby acknowledged & Confessed as by these presents herein all  
and deliver unto the said Lumsden... & Co. Five Hundred  
two Logs now lying at the Yellow River Boom at our mill, five  
hundred thousand feet Merchantable Edge Board & twenty five  
thousand feet Shanty now stacked up at our mill and whatever  
Lumber we may make at our mill, until the Indebtedness  
hereinafter described, is fully satisfied and discharged. To have and  
to hold unto the said Lumsden... & Co. their sole use and  
benefit forever

The Conditions of the foregoing instrument is as follows  
To wit: Wherein the said Marguis & Co. are indebted to said Lumsden  
& Co. by two Drafts on L. M. Muritt & Son, one for \$860<sup>00</sup> due August  
24<sup>th</sup> 1878, and one for \$874<sup>00</sup> due Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1878 also the sum of three  
thousand Dollars as shown by the Books of said Lumsden... & Co.  
Now if the said Marguis & Co. shall well and truly pay said sums  
of money and also all such other sums as may be advanced to them  
by said Lumsden... & Co. in either Cash or supplies from time  
to time then this instrument to be void else to remain in  
full force & Virtue
