Columbia July 20th 1878

It is hereby agreed between John Davidson of Santa Rosa County and Simon Hubbard and Co of Columbia County Ga that the said Davidson is to cut and deliver to S R Co. mill prime to Jan 1st 1879 one thousand good prime saw logs fifteen inches up in diameter free from visible defects for which said S R Co agree to pay said Davidson at the rate of five dollars per thousand feet, as follows to advance to said Davidson such supplies as he may require to run to Logging team in hauling said logs and pay raftsmen, the balance to be paid when S R Co can realize from their lumber the coming fall the said logs to be hauled S R with Stamp brand who hauls and are then delivered as the property of Simon Hubbard and Co

sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell and
convey unto the said Joseph Allinger his heirs and assigns
all the following property to wit one schooner named W Smith her
tackle and apparel together with all and singular the appurtenances
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining

this 15th 3rd of
April 1879

And assign forever upon this condition that whereas the
said J Boghich and Catharine Boghich did on the 7th day of
September AD 1878 execute and deliver to the said Joseph Allinger
their joint promissory note in writing for one hundred and fifty
Dollars and payable one day after date thereof with eight per cent
interest from date and the better to secure the said promissory note
they have this day made and executed this Bill of sale for the
aforesaid schooner which is intended as a mortgage or lien on
said schooner until said promissory note is fully paid and
discharged now if the said J Boghich and C Boghich shall well
and truly pay or cause to be paid the aforesaid promissory note
according to its tenor and effect then this mortgage or lien
to be of no effect else to remain in full force and virtue
