We the undersigned being heirs & only heirs at Law of Richard P. David late of Santa Rosa County and State of Florida deceased, who died intestate and being joined in his life time and at the time of his death of diverse goods and chattels lands and tenements in his own right, and whereas the said heirs being of lawful age and desirous that the estate both real and personal of the said deceased should be settled up and distributed without an administration thereon we the said undersigned have constituted and appointed and by these presents do constitute and appoint Wiley J. Williams husband of Margaret, who was Margaret M. David, but now Margaret Williams, wife of said Wiley J. Williams, and lawful heir and daughter of said deceased our legal and lawful Attorney for us and for each and every one of us, and in our name, place and stead, with full power and authority to take charge of the said estate of the said deceased, to sell and dispose of so much thereof as shall be required and necessary to pay the debts in which the deceased stood liable for and bound to pay at his death and also for an equitable distribution and equal distribution among the legal and lawful heirs at Law of said deceased and to pay the expenses and disbursements which our said Attorney shall see necessary to be made in making a final settlement of said estate and in the distribution thereof among the said heirs to give execute and deliver in our names and for us, good and lawful legal warranted titles or titles to such as he may see, and to give execute and deliver to each distributee of said estate a title or showing for each distributee's share of said estate in the name and for each of the other distributees retained, thereof the distributive share of his wife the said Margaret Williams - to do and perform anything or act necessary to be done and performed in order to carry out the powers herein and hereby provided for and required to be done; - to keep an exact account of his doings and doings in the premises showing what came into his hands belonging to the estate of said deceased, what he shall sell thereout for debts against the deceased and to whom paid, the money which he shall pay by way of expenses in the discharge of the debts we assigned to him, the distributive share of each heir naming the property or money as the one may be and the estimated value thereof and the name of the heir to whom the same shall be distributed taking a receipt for the same, and to cause this power of Attorney together with such schedule and receipts for distributive shares to be recorded in the office of the Probate Court of the County of Nassau hereby ratifying and confirming all and every thing which our said Attorney shall lawfully do a course to be done in the premises
