me that they signed sealed and delivered the foregoing power of attorney for
the uses and purposes therein mentioned and the same is their respective

Railer and four Acres bought by one from Andrew Mitchell and
known as the Mitchell team, warranted free of incumbrances and
against any adverse claim. Upon condition that if the said E.
W. Cobb shall pay to the said W. David & Byrne, Two Hundred Dollars
with interest at 8 per cent. from date agreeably to a promissory note
of this date for that sum, payable to the said W. David & Byrne or
order on demand with interest, this mortgage shall be void otherwise
in full force and effect. That until the condition of this instrument
is broken the said property may remain in possession of the
said E. W. Cobb, but after condition broken the said W. David
