Reuben Stogall the part of the second part. The premises described lands
to wit the South East quarter of the south west quarter quarter and
the West half of the South west quarter of section No. 12 town one
in R. No 5 five Nor of Ra (24) twenty four West County 15th 18th
Cross hundred and nineteen acres 118⁰⁰ together with all the hundred
thereunto belong or in any wise appertaining together with all rights
title interest Claims or demands where and to hold forever and
the party of the first part agrees to warrant and forever defend the
party of the second part in the peaceable and quiet enjoyment
