To wit Lot No 4 in Block # 45 adjoining Lot No 21 in same Block containing 100 ft front on Cross Street by 100 ft in Depth with appurtenances

To have and to hold the above described property unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever

To have and to hold unto the said Joseph Ferrigan his heirs and executors and administrators to their sole use and behoof from the above instrument intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of a promissory note of even date herewith for the sum of one hundred and five & 25/100 Dollars due the 20th of April AD 1880
