Santa Rosa County } of Florida in a Cause wherein Harriet S Keyser Executrix
of William J Keyser Decedent, was Complainant and Amelia
L Rome and Harriette Rome were Defendants, on the 11th Day of April AD
1879. The Hon J E Maxwell Judge of the first Judicial Circuit rendered a Verdict
that Amelia L Rome one of the Defendants was indebted to the Complainant
in the sum of Nine Hundred and thirty Dollars and twenty Cents
and that the separate property of the said Amelia L Rome was subject
to the payment of the aforesaid sum of Nine Hundred and thirty
