in hand paid by Henry Bray the receipt in hereof is hereby
acknowledged have given granted bargained and sold and
by these presents do give grant bargain & sell unto the said
Henry Bray his heirs and assigns the following personal property
to wit: Two Log Carts One Iron Stake and one wooden axe
with Cast Iron Hammers and Chains Complete Also Eight Oxen
as follows, one red mingled horned bullock, one blue horned Ox
one red Plea bitten named Boff, one yellow headed named Brown,
one red Plea bitten known as the Gains Steer named Brandy,
one black and white Pided named Buck, 1 white black headed
named Dove, one yellow and white Pided named Ball, and one
Kaan Horse. To have and to hold unto the said Henry Bray
his heirs and assigns forever upon this condition that whereas
the said George W Bray had this day made and executed his
promissory note in writing for one hundred Dollars payable
Eight months after date to Henry Bray or bearer, and for
the better to secure the said promissory note he has this day
made and executed this Bill of sale which is intended as a
mortgage on said above described personal property until
said promissory note is fully paid and discharged. Now if
the said George W Bray shall well and truly pay a Cash
and effect thereof then this instrument to be of no effect else
to remain in full force and virtue
