This Indenture made the tenth day of December in the year of one thousand Eight hundred and Sixty Eight between Philip Beut of Saint Boyan Santa Rosa County, State of Florida of the one part and James R Lee of said Boyan County and state of the second part Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Lawful Money of the United States of America to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he remised released and quit Claimed and by these presents does remise release and quit Claim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all that piece of land in Santa Rosa County, State of Florida as embodied in the accompanying plot made by Theodore Mearns Survey the same conveyed to said Lee by M S Hornumdy and Wife on 3rd Dec 1866

To wit that of Commonly on the West shore of Escambia Bay Tree on the left marked with three crosses and running N 86° 40' East over a Large Oak Stump partly burned and near the starting point to the back line of the Hornumdy 5921 feet thence along the line to a point 842 feet at right angle from the 1st line S 86° 40' W to a lightwood stake on the shore thence along the shore to the starting point.
