This Indenture made this 27th day of March ad 1880 between Harriet S Keyser of the town of Milton in the County of Santa Rosa and State of Florida party of the first part and Abraham Johnson, Anderson Odum, Daniel Scott, Lewis Jackson and George Laskins, as trustees of the Mount Pelgrim African Baptist Church of said County and State of the second part themselves that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred Dollars to her in hand paid by the parties of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said parties of the second part their successors and assigns all of that certain piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the town of Milton in said State & County and known and described as follows to wit

Lot No two (2) in Block Seventy (70) as per Lee & Dams Survey which adjoins Lot No One (1) of said Block fronting on Alice Ann St. two hundred and ten (210) feet running back from said street one hundred and forty four (144) feet within parallel lines being a part of the tract originally entered by George Walker and a part of the Lot of two hundred and ten feet bought by Joseph H Rome from Dillon far as by deed bearing date March 17th 1855 together with all & singular the appurtenances and hereditaments thereto belonging

To have and to hold the above described property unto the parties of the second part their successors and assigns forever
