his right title interest estate, Claim and demand both at law
and in equity and as well in possession as in expectation of in and
to the undivided half of Eight Hundred Acres granted to Francis
Poussin in the year of our Lord 1817 known as the Bull tract
with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
