This agreement made and entered into this the 29th Day of May AD
1880 between George J Baden and James D Leary of the City and
State of New York of the one part and Marquis & Co of the State of
Florida and County of Santa Rosa of the other part Witnesseth that
whereas the said Baden & Leary hereby agree to furnish the said Marquis
& Co with saw logs to run their ^{mill} in the County of Santa Rosa
aforesaid the said Marquis & Co to purchase said logs as the agent
of said Baden and Leary by means to be furnished to said Marquis
& Co by said Baden and Leary and the said Marquis & Co hereby agree
to saw on their steam saw mill all logs as furnished by said Baden
and Leary It is hereby understood and agreed that all saw logs so
purchased as above described and all products from them of any
kind or description of either lumber or sawn timber shall be
and remain the property of the said Baden & Leary

It is further understood and agreed between said parties that
said Marquis & Co shall ship all lumber or timber made or produced
from said logs so purchased as aforesaid as may be directed by
said Baden and Leary

It is further understood and agreed that as a compensation
to said Marquis & Co for purchasing and sawing said logs
that said Baden and Leary will pay to said Marquis & Co
the market price of the lumber manufactured from said logs
after deducting therefrom all sums of money paid them in purchase
