unto the said Thomas Levings and his assigns forever the following
goods & Chattels to wit: Eight head of Cattle marked with a Swallow Tail
under bit & over bit in each ear and branded thirteen on the hip
warranted free from incumbrance & against any adverse Claims
Upon Condition that if the said George Howell & Mary Howell pay
to the said Thomas Levings by the 1st day of January 1880 Dollars agreeably to a promissory note
of this date, for that sum payable to the said Levings four (4) months
after date this deed shall be void otherwise remain in full force &
effect.

The aforesaid parties agree that until the Condition of this
instrument is broken, the said property may remain in
possession of the said George Howell & Mary Howell but after
Condition broken the said Levings may take & remove the same
to his possession
