No 12 Is that portion of the County embraced within the following boundaries to wit:

Commencing at the Mouth of Yellow River and running up said River to where Township line divides 1 & 2 Crosses said River thence East to Range line dividing 25 & 26 South on said line to Coe River thence down East River to the Mouth Bay thence down said Bay to Blackwater River thence up said River to the Mouth of Yellow River and the voting place to be at Henry's Alley.

No 13 Is that portion of the County Embraced within the following Boundaries to wit:

Commencing on Blackwater 1/2 Miles North of the Township line dividing 1 North & 1 South thence west on said Line to Escambia Bay thence down said Bay to Blackwater Bay thence up said Bay to the Starting Point and the voting place to be at the School House at Head of Indian Bayou

No 14 Is that portion of the County embraced within the following boundaries to wit:

Commencing on Blackwater River where Section Line between Sections 11 & 14 Crosses said River thence west on said Line to Big Water Creek thence up said Creek to the East prong thence up said East Prong to Township Line dividing 3 & 4 thence East on said line to range line dividing 26 & 27 thence on a South East Course to Blackwater River to the beginning and the voting place to be at the school House at the place known as the McEllon place;

No 15 Is that portion of the County embraced within the following Boundaries to wit:

Commencing on Big Juniper Creek where Township line dividing 3 & 4 Crosses said Creek thence up said Creek to the Alabama Line thence West on said Line to the Road known as the Byers Road thence down said Road to Township Line dividing 3 & 4 thence East on said Line to Big Juniper Creek and the voting place to be at Wm Micks
