Know all men by these presents that the trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund under an act of the General Assembly of the State of Florida entitled an act to provide for and encourage a Liberal system of Internal Improvements in this State passed January 6th 1833 for and in consideration of the sum of twenty cents per acre to them in hand paid by Emory P. Skinner of the County of Escambia State of Florida have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain grant sell and convey unto the said Emory P. Skinner and his heirs and assigns forever the following described Lands to wit

Sections Twenty, Twenty one, Twenty two and Twenty five in township one South of Range twenty eight West County Seven Secord and Twenty ⁵²/₁₀₀ Acre and more and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida

Alone and to hold unto the said Emory P. Skinner and his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple
