Know all men by these presents that we Wm P Merrill and Elizabeth Merrill of the State of Florida and County of Pensacola for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to us in hand paid by G. Swift of the date aforesaid and sum of mellen the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Swift

his heirs and assigns the following real estate lying and being situated in the state aforesaid and County of Santa Rosa and within the Corporate limits of the Town of Milton and known and described in the plan of said Town as Lots nos one two three four (1, 2, 3 & 4) being the lots on which is situated the residence lately occupied by us in the Town of Milton to have and to hold unto the said Swift his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever. The foregoing instrument is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of a promissory note of even date herewith for the sum of seven hundred Dollars with eight per cent interest from date until paid made by us the said Wm P Merrill and Elizabeth Merrill in favor of said Swift and due April 29th AD 1882 now if the said Merrill shall pay said note at maturity then this instrument shall void else to remain in full force and virtue. It is further understood and agreed that said Swift is to have the Charge and Control of said mortgaged property and shall have the right to collect the rents due for the same during the term of this Mortgage and it is also understood that in the event of default made in the payment of the debt secured hereby and in case the said Swift shall foreclose this Mortgage we agree to pay his reasonable attorney fees therefor. And the said Elizabeth Merrill hereby consent to the alienation and mortgaging said property.
