Containing Fifty Acres of the District of Lands Subject to sale at Public Sale Florida together with all and singular the Remediments and appurtenances thereto belonging in anywise appertaining and the revenues and revenues remainders and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also all estate right title interest claim or claim and whatsoever of the said party of the first part either in law or Equity of or in and to the above bargained premises with the said Remediments and appurtenances to have and to hold the said premises above particularly mentioned and described to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever and the said party of the first part for him self and his heirs with hereby Covenant to warrant and defend the said party of the second part in the Peace and quiet enjoyment of the premises hereby conveyed,
