also four Yokes of Oxen described as follows to wit: Two Iron Axe
Log Carts with Roller & Chain Complete also four Yokes of Oxen
described as follows: Two Black Oxen named Dick & Buck, two Red
Oxen each named Paul - One Black spotted or named Pat - One Red Ox
named Buck - One Blue eyed Ox named Chocky - One Bandler
or named Pete, it here and to hold unto the said Joseph Allinger
his heirs and assigns forever. The above instrument is intended
as a mortgage to secure the said Joseph Allinger in the payment
of an account due him for advances to me for the sum of Four
Hundred & five & 1/4 Dollars and such other sums or supplies
that he may advance me in the Course of my business hereafter
run. If the said Humphreys shall ever and truly pay all advances
of money due or to become due then this obligation to be void
else to remain in full force and virtue
