day give great bargain and mortgage unto Edwin
Murphy a certain sailing vessel built by me on Saint Bayou

length over all and fourteen feet beam or thereabout which
said sailing craft is named Pamela Thome and to hold under the
following conditions and circumstances to wit, that whereas the
said Edwin Murphy has this day loaned me the sum of forty Dollars
to purchase coal for said vessel, I the said Louis Anderson have
presented to him the said Murphy a promissory note dated the 8th
of June 1882 and due six months after date with interest at ten
per cent per annum. It is concluded and agreed by the parties
that if said note is paid as contracted together with all cost of mortgage
or suit which may necessarily accrue in the collection of the said
note then the mortgage said to be null and void otherwise remain
in full force and effect
