part witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in  
consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars of good and lawful  
money of the United States of America to him in hand paid by  
the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged and confessed, hath bargained granted sold conveyed  
and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain grant sell  
convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part their  
heirs and assigns the following described land to wit a Lot or  
parcel of Land lying and being situate in the state and County  
first above written and embraced within the limits of the  
Corporation of the Town of Malton and County aforesaid and  
thus described Commencing at the S. E. Corner of the S. E. 1/4  
of the N. E. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 34 Township 3 North Range  
28 West and running thence due West one acre and thence due  
North to the Lot as the W. 1/2 of 2 Guild Lot and thence due East one  
acre and thence due South to the Starting Corner Containing  
about one acre nine eighths Together with all and singular  
the Hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in  
anywise appertaining and the revenues and revenues reserved  
and remainders, rents issues right tithes interest Claims or  
demands whatsoever of the said party of the first part either in law
