Whereas in pursuance of the acts of Congress of March 2<sup>nd</sup> 1855  
 and March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1857 a special Certificate number four and dated  
 the twenty sixth day of March 1851 was issued by the Commission  
 of the General Land Office authorizing the State of Florida to  
 locate twenty thousand six hundred and fifty eight and 2/10  
 acres of Land as the indemnity contemplated by the second  
 section of the aforesaid act of March 2<sup>nd</sup> 1853 and whereas the said  
 Certificate was sold by the trustees of the Internal Improvement  
 Fund to William J Dankirk for the sum of twelve thousand  
 three hundred and eighty eight Dollars and ninety seven Cents  
 which amount was paid in full by the said purchaser and the  
 said Certificate was assigned to him with authority to select  
 the Lands to be located in satisfaction thereof by which sale  
 and assignment the said William J Dankirk or his assigns  
 became entitled to a conveyance of the lands located with said  
 Certificate whenever the same should hereafter be patented to  
 the State of Florida and whereas the said purchaser made his  
 selection of lands and returned a list thereof to the General  
 Land Office together with said Certificate and the lands so  
 selected have been conveyed to the State of Florida by a  
 Land Indemnity Patent number four and dated the eighth  
 day of October 1851 and whereas the said William J Dankirk has  
 assigned to Emory J Skinner of the County of Escambia  
 State of Florida the following described lands part of the lands
