and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and Convey
unto the said Charles Meidinger his heirs and assigns a
Certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situate in said
State and County and having been purchased by the said Andrew
J. Lane of George Marguis Sr. of said State and County and
described in said Marguis deed of Conveyance to said A. J. Lane
dated Aug 17th 1882 as follows to wit: The place now occupied
by Archibald Anderson lying between the place now owned and
occupied by the said A. J. Lane and a place recently purchased
by said Lane from Melchior Fisher fronting south on the P. & F.
R. R. - Extending north on the East line of the place now occupied
by said Lane (9) Chains and (84) Links to a lightwood post - thence
due East (6) Chains & (22) Links to the R. R. Corner of the said Fisher
place. Marked by a lightwood post thence south by the west line
