Know all men by these presents that we Polly Sheppard, George Perry and Charles Perry of the City of Pensacola and State of Florida for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Joseph Allinger of the State of Florida and the County of Santa Rosa the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged said Confessors have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph Allinger his heirs and assigns the following real Estate situate in said State and County and within the Corporate limits of the Town of Milton and known and described on the plan of said Town as follows Lot (No 7) shown on Block No (19) Division the said lot fronting on Adams Street and being one hundred and forty seven feet and six inches square. Also that certain lot of Land in said Town said Lot of Land being known in November AD 1848 on the plan of said Town as the property of Mark & Marshall and at said time occupied as a residence of Capt George Perry and at present occupied by Joseph C. Amos commencing at the North East corner of said Lot as occupied and running southwardly along the margin of Milling Street seventy feet thence westwardly the depth of square half acre thence northwardly seventy feet on a Line parallel with Milling Street thence Eastwardly to the place of beginning the same being known also as Lot No 6 in Block (19) Division also Lots No (13527) one three four and seven on Block (38) thirty Eight also the undivided one half of Lot No (648) six and eight on Block No (22) twenty two.
