Malcolm McMillan

Know all men by these presents that the trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund under an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Florida entitled an Act to provide for and encourage a liberal system of Internal Improvements in this state approved January 18th 1853 for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and twenty five cents per acre to them in hand paid by Malcolm McMillan and Angus McMillan of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida here granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Malcolm McMillan & Angus McMillan and their heirs and assigns forever the following described lands to wit: The Lot numbered four of Section 34 in Township Nine North of Range Thirty West Containing one hundred and forty six ^{63/100} acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said state of Florida

To have and to hold unto the said Malcolm McMillan & Angus McMillan and their heirs and assigns forever

In testimony whereof said trustees hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and here caused an impression of the seal of the Florida State Land Office to be made hereupon at the Capital in the City of Tallahassee on the 26th Day of November AD Eighteen Hundred and Eighty four
