Know all men by these presents that the Trustees of the Internal Improvement fund under an act of the General Assembly of the State of Florida entitled an act to provide for and encourage a liberal system of Internal Improvements in this State; approved January 6th 1853 for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety cents per acre to them in hand paid by Rufus Milligan, James A. Choffin and Francis Ferrigan of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Rufus Milligan, James A. Choffin and Francis Ferrigan and their heirs and assigns forever the following described lands to wit - The East half of the South West quarter of Section Twenty seven in Township Five North of Range Twenty three West Containing seventy five 1/20 Acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida

And have and to hold unto the said Rufus Milligan, James A. Choffin and Francis Ferrigan and their heirs and assigns forever in fee simple

In testimony whereof a majority of said trustees have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and have caused an impression of the seal of the Florida State land office to be made hereunto
