Whereas in pursuance of the Act of Congress of March 2, 1853 and March 3, 1857 a special Certificate from Land Run and dated the twenty ninth day of March 1861 was issued by the Commissioner of the General Land Office authorizing the State of Florida to locate twenty thousand six hundred and forty eight 2/3 Acres of the land as Indemnity contemplated by the second section of the aforesaid Act of March 2^d 1853. And whereas the said Certificate was sold by the trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund to William J. Vanhook for the sum of Twelve thousand three hundred and Eighty Eight Dollars and forty seven cents which amount was paid in full by the said purchaser and the said Certificate was assigned to him with authority to select the lands to be located in satisfaction thereof by which sale and assignment the said William J. Vanhook a his assigns became entitled to a Conveyance of the lands located with said Certificate whenever the same should thereafter be patented to the State of Florida and whereas the said purchaser made his selection of lands and returned a list thereof to the General Land Office together with said Certificate and the lands so selected have been conveyed to the State of Florida by special Land Indemnity Patent from Land Run and dated the
