Now then the said Anderson Odum agrees with the said Creary to keep in good order and repair said Carriage and to use the same for the transportation of passengers only and to pay unto the said Creary that sum of Twenty five (25) Dollars or more in consideration of the same and it is also agreed and understood that I shall retain the possession and use of said mortgaged property until the expiration of this instrument - Now then if the said Creary shall well and truly perform his part of the said agreement and the said Odum shall well and truly comply with and fulfill my said agreement then this instrument to be null and void else in case the said Creary having fulfilled his said agreement and the said Odum having failed in mine, this instrument to be of full force and virtue.
