party of the first part agrees the payment of a note given by him to

on said note bearing date of June 31 1884 does bargain sell and by
these presents does grant and convey unto the party of the second part
his heirs or assigns forever the following property: one Chest

left upon the express Condition that whenever the party of the
first part shall sell and truly pay to the party of the second
part his heirs and assigns the amount of said obligation together
with interest & Cost of Collection then this obligation to be void
& of no effect otherwise to be of full force and intent. In testimony
