I am indebted to said Joseph Allinger in the sum of
Two Hundred and Eighty Eight $\frac{7}{10}$ Dollars (\$288 $\frac{7}{10}$) for
advances made by him to me now if the said Burke
shall will and truly pay the said indebtedness and
such further sums as the said Allinger may advance
the said Burke in money or supplies then this obliga-
tion is to be void else to remain in full force and
virtue
