 aforesaid and that registered as a part of Lot number two on  
 the plan of lots which Keyser had laid out by John H. Walker then  
 County Surveyor on the north half of Lot number three or  
 fractional Section number three in Township one north of  
 Range (28) twenty eight West Commencing at the North East Corner  
 of Lot Number two (2) one hundred and twenty feet thence  
 due west through said Lot number two (2) Two hundred and  
 ten feet thence due north to the line of said Lot number two  
 one hundred and twenty feet thence due east on the line of  
 said Lot number two (2) Two hundred and ten feet to the place  
 of beginning. Also a lot of land bought from the estate of G. Thomas  
 Beal and described as follows Commencing at a point located  
 due west from the South East Corner of the Lot of land above
