Know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred & fifty (\$850⁰⁰) Dollars paid and assumed to be paid by Joseph Allinger to the Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company a Corporation chartered by the State of Florida the receipt whereof is hereby granted acknowledge the said Pensacola & Atlantic Rail Road Company has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and convey unto said Joseph Allinger all the following tracts or parcels of land situate in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida and described as follows to wit: The NW 1/4, N 1/2 of SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section Seventeen (17) Township Three (3) North of Range Twenty four (24) West Entire Section one (1) E 1/2 of NE 1/4, S 1/4 of NE 1/4, S E 1/4 and S E 1/4 of S 1/4 of Section Eleven (11) S E 1/4 of S 1/4 of Section Twelve (12) N 1/2 of N 1/2 and SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section Thirteen (13) N 1/4 of N E 1/4 and E 1/2 of N 1/4 of Section Fourteen (14) and N 1/2 of N E 1/4 and N 1/4 of S E 1/4 of Section Twenty three (23) Block Three (3) N Range Twenty five (25) W. Containing seventeen hundred & twenty (1720) Acres more or less to have and to hold unto the said Joseph Allinger his heirs & assigns and assigns forever. Now therefore in consideration of the premises the said Pensacola & Atlantic Rail Road Company hereby warrants and defends the title in and to the aforesaid premises to the said Joseph Allinger in fee simple forever and in pursuance of the third Section in the mortgage executed by the said Pensacola & Atlantic Rail Road Company to Edmund S. Randolph and John L. Caldwell as trustees dated 1st April 1854 duly acknowledged and assumed the said Randolph and Caldwell as trustees hereby convey all their interest as said trustees in said Land to the said Joseph Allinger this deed being as to them a quit claim. ~~The~~ trustees and warrant warrant as title by them

in testimony whereof the said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company has hereunto and by authority of a resolution of its board of Directors signed this instrument by its President and attested the same by causing the seal of the Company to be affixed by its secretary and the said Edmund S. Randolph and John L. Caldwell trustees &c have hereunto set their hands and seals on this the 30th day of March 1855
