As well as our interest in & to the franchise of said ferry with the flats and boats and rigging thereto belonging. To have and to hold the above described real estate with the improvements and appurtenances and the said Ferry Franchise giving and granting unto our said attorney full power and Authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises as fully to all intents and purposes as we might or could do if personally present hereby ratifying and Confirming all that our said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof
