Whereas there has been reported on the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the register of the Land office at Lawrence Kansas whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 to secure donations to actual settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Mary E Rogers widow of John Rogers deceased has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the Lot number six of Section seven town in Township two South of Range twenty four West of Dallasess Meridian in Florida Containing one hundred acres and fifty ~~four~~ ^{square} rods of an acre according to the official Plat of the survey of the said Land returned to the General Land office by the Surveyor General
