Know all men by these presents that I John Newton of Santa Rosa County State of Florida for and in consideration of the same amount of land due to me by Mary E Rogers widow of John Rogers deceased of the State and County a true mention the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed and have quiet granted bargained & changed and conveyed and by these presents do give grant exchange and convey unto said Mary E Rogers her heirs and assigns the following real estate lying and being situated in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida and known and described as follows To wit A Portion in Lot Number Five (5) Section Eleventh (11) Township Two (2) South Range Twenty four (24) that said portion of land lying at the West corner (7) chains East of West boundary line of said Lot Number five (5) and crossing due West to boundary line of said Lot Number five (5) thence East Twenty three (23) chains to North boundary line thence East Twenty three (23) chains to the point of starting Beginning Sixty Eight and seventy one hundredths (68.71) Acres thereunto where and to hold the same unto the said Mary E Rogers her heirs and assigns in fee simple forever and I the undersigned John Newton for myself my heirs executors and administrators do consent to and warrant and defend the same unto the said Mary E Rogers her heirs and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of any and all persons whatsoever
