Containing 136 1/2 acres also lot No. (1) in Section twenty two fractional Township one (1) Range twenty nine N. 21 Containing 102 1/2 also Lot No. (2) two in Section thirty two fractional Township (1) Range twenty nine N. 21 Containing 157 1/2 acres also fractional section thirty three in fractional Township (1) Range twenty nine Containing 127 1/4 acres all the aforesaid lands lying and being in said State and County to have and to hold unto the said Martha P. Price Heir and assigns in fee simple forever.
