granted bargained & sold & by these presents do give grant bargain sell  
& convey unto the said Ollinger & Garrison the following described  
property To wit The S 1/4 of the N E 1/4 of Sec 4 - Township one Range 28  
& 1/2 N Containing 19 Acres, also one Roan Horse about 5 years old  
one Bay Colored Horse about 4 years old and Buggy, the yoke of Oxen  
& Wagon being the Oxen & Wagon now in possession of Frank Conly  
to have & to hold the aforesaid property to the said Ollinger & Garrison  
their heirs Executors, administrators assigns forever. The  
Condition of this obligation is such that whereas the said Ollinger  
& Garrison here this day become sureties on the bond of the said Julio C  
& Howell for his appearance at the next term of the Circuit Court to  
be holden in & for said County of term to term to answer such  
Indictment if any as may be found by the Grand Jury of said  
County and the said Sureties shall be legally discharged from their  
liability on said bond then this obligation to be void else to remain  
in full force and virtue.
