 respectfully 1st. Yellow River, Shoal River, Pond Creek. River Log Creek  
 Horse Creek in the State of Nevada and upon which said Rivers and  
 Creeks the said Meigs has been and is engaged in the business  
 of log getting and marked or branded them respectively with "B"  
 (1613) "□" (square) "△" (triangle) also "X" and "MX" (the last two Brands  
 being what is known as Chop Brands) also one Log Cut and one Team  
 of Oxen (consisting of 2 Hacks) and harness and attached as the  
 property of Meigs and now being driven by a Driver in his employ  
 by name of Lamb Truck and said Team and last being being  
 known as the Lamb Truck, both Team and now in Walker County  
 State Nevada also all River Tools Camp Equipments Boat & etc  
 owned & now being used by Meigs in his logging business.

To have and to hold all of said property unto the said Bonds  
 his Executors Administrators and assigns Whom there are &  
 heirs forever And the said Meigs for himself his heirs and  
 assigns Covenant with the said Bonds that he is lawfully possessed  
 of said Property and his right to sell the same and that the same is free  
 from incumbrances whatever same such as may be held against it  
 by Bonds his or which are by the Covenants of the said Bonds hereafter  
 mentioned Meigs doth & covenants that he will  
 protect and defend the title to said property unto the said Bonds his  
 Executors Administrators assigns against any and all persons  
 whatsoever and against any and all Claims for labor or otherwise  
 and against any and all Claims that may be brought by the United  
 States Government or by any Rail Road Company whatsoever. The said  
 Meigs furthermore agrees to put into the River or Creek as the Case  
 may be all of said logs that are not in the water which are near the  
 bank of said Rivers & Creeks hereafter mentioned respectively and  
 that he will drive or run such of said logs that are in Shoal River  
 down a line what is known as the fork of said River and Pond  
 Creek to said Fork for the said Bonds at his own expense &  
 Furthermore that he will retain the services of Jack McCallan  
 Coach Driver and Joe Ward persons now in his employ with  
 the respective teams now being driven by them in cutting  
 hauling & putting in logs until the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1894 said Logs  
 thus put in to be hauled on one of said Brands mentioned and to be  
 carried a part of the Logs already mentioned & hauled (the said  
 Bonds agreeing to furnish fuel for said Teams) and Meigs at his own  
 expense to employ said persons & teams The said Meigs furthermore
