To have and to hold the same unto the said Mr Judge & Matha F Judge their Executors Administrators & assigns for ever. And we the said Geo Marguis Sr & Mary R Marguis do Avowt & agree with the said Mr Judge & Matha F Judge that we will warrant & defend the title of the said sheep against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
