of Florida and embraced within the incorporate limits of the Town
of Milton and known on the plan of said Town as Fractional Block
Number (16) Sixteen with all the appurtenances thereto belonging

heirs and assigns forever and I the said grantor do hereby
Covenant and agree with the said Mrs J. R. Harrison that I
