and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto

estate lying and being situated in the County of Santa Rosa State of  
Florida to wit all of the land immediately East of the land that Thome here  
before sold to John Ollinger by Deed dated 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1885 as Recorded  
in Book 6 page 711, in Section Eleven (11) Township one (1) North of Range  
28 West. Together with all and singular the appurtenances and improve-  
ments thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold  
the same unto the said John Blackburn his heirs and assigns in  
fee Simple forever and I the said Joseph Ollinger for myself my heirs  
Executors and administrators do hereby Covenant to warrant and defend  
the said John Blackburn his heirs and assigns in the title and quiet  
enjoyment of the premises hereby conveyed
