Know all men by these presents that we Cyrus Snodgrass and Louisa
 & Snodgrass wife of said Cyrus Snodgrass who for in full for the purpose
 of relinquishing her right of dower to the land herein. Arrived of the
 State of Nevada and County of Santa Rosa for and in Consideration of five
 Dollars to us in hand paid by Henry W Snodgrass of the State and County
 aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and Confessed have
 given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give
 grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Henry W Snodgrass his
 heirs and assigns the following described real estate lying and being
 situate in said state and County to wit: the undivided one third interest
 in the lot of ground known as the Baydad Lash Pottery lot and as
 described in the plan of the Village formerly known as Baydad but
 now known as Blackwater which plan was drawn by W F Lee. said
 lot measuring (200) two hundred feet on Water street (190) five
 hundred and ninety feet on Camp street two hundred (200) feet on
 Simpson street and five hundred and ninety (190) feet on Elko
 street also the undivided one third interest in the lot or piece of
 ground on the opposite of Water street measuring (200) two hundred
 feet on Water street and lying between Water street and Blackwater
 River being the same on which the Pottery Warehouse and lumber
 Beck are located also the undivided one third interest in lots and
 lots three four five and six (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) in Block fourteen (14) being
 the whole of said block according to the said plan by W F Lee bounded
 on the north by Overman street East by Simpson street south by
 Bushnell street and West by Poych street together with the undivided
 third part in all and singular the improvement of whatever kind
 or Character thereon where and to hold unto the said Henry W
 Snodgrass his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever. The above
 instrument is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the
 balance due on a promissory note drawn by Cyrus Snodgrass May
 1st 1881 in favor of said Henry W Snodgrass for the thousand five
 hundred Dollars on which there is now due three thousand nine
 hundred and Eighteen & 90/100 Dollars Two of the said Snodgrass shall
 well and truly pay said note then this instrument to be void
 else to remain in full force and virtue
