 of one Dollar to me in hand paid, by Joseph Olliger, of said State & County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed, here given granted bargain and sold, and by the said Olliger do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Olliger his executors, administrators and assigns, the following personal property now lying in the County of Santa Rosa, Florida, and in my possession and ownership, shown and described as follows - to wit: One yoke (2 head) of Oxen, one of a Yellow, and the other a brown color, and named respectively "Buck" & "John", also one yoke (2 head) of oxen, one of a Red and the other a Black & white color named to wit "Jack" and "Charlie", also one yoke (2 head) of Oxen, of yellow color, with white faces named to wit "Bill" & "Brandy", also one (1) yoke (2 head) of Oxen, one a Round sided, and the other a black color, with white faces, named "Bill" & "Lyon", also one Saddle 7ft high (wheels) with Iron felloes. To have and to hold said property unto the said Joseph Olliger, his executors administrators assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. Now the above instrument is intended as a Mortgage, the condition of which are these - to wit: That whereas the said James E. Jourigan is indebted to the said Olliger in a further amount of (\$225 ⁶⁸/₁₀₀) Two hundred and twenty five ⁶⁸/₁₀₀ Dollars, for goods, wares, and merchandise on account, and whereas furthermore the said Olliger & Jourigan have contracted that said Olliger shall advance to said Jourigan goods, wares and merchandise to an amount not to exceed to wit, inclusive of said note and said account about - to wit - (\$1000 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀) One thousand Dollars, from time to time, as the said Jourigan may here occasion to require same, in a business of log getting which is to be conducted by him in the County of Santa Rosa, Florida
