consideration of one Dollar to us in hand paid by Henry Bray
of the same State and County, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged and confessed, have given, granted, bargained
and sold, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell and
convey unto Henry Bray, the following personal property, the
same being in Santa Rosa County State of Florida, and known
and described as follows - To wit - Five Yoke (10 head) of Oxen
the same being certain Oxen once owned and afterwards sold by Henry
Bray to Geo W Rutherford and now owned by said Rutherford and
Henry Bray in partnership, & now in their possession & use, also
(a) Two Log Carts - one of said Carts having 6 1/2 ft wheels, and
the other wheels of about 4 ft in diameter, both of said Carts
having Iron Axles, and being the same once owned by Henry
Bray and by him sold to Mrs W Rutherford, also certain improvements
belonging to said Rutherford & Geo Bray situated on the land of Simpson
& Co to wit a Blacksmith shop, together with the tools, apparatus
& material now in same shop being situated in the neighborhood of
locality known as Bailey Ford in the County of Santa Rosa
