Know all men by these presents that the Board of Education of Florida under an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled an act to establish a uniform system of Common Schools and a University approved January 30<sup>th</sup> 1869 and the present Constitution of the State for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and twenty five Cents per acre to them in hand paid by Martha C Newmon here granted her gained and deed and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Martha C Newmon and her heirs and assigns forever the following described Lands to wit the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Eighteen in Township one North of Range Twenty Eight West Containing Thirty Nine and 9/16<sup>ths</sup> Acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida Where and to hold the said Land unto the said Martha C Newmon and her heirs and assigns forever

In testimony whereof the members of said Board here hereto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and here caused the seal of the Florida State Land Office to be hereunto affixed at the Capitol in the City of Tallahassee on this Thirtieth day of October AD Eighteen hundred and Eighty Seven
