Know all men by these presents that the Board of Education of Florida under an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled an act to establish a uniform system of common schools and a University approved January 30th 1869 and the present Constitution of said State for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and twenty five Cents per acre within in hand paid by Alexander H Green of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida here granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Alexander H Green and his heirs and assigns forever the following described lands to wit The South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Sixteen in Township one North of Range Twenty Eight West containing thirty nine and 7/10 acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida To have and to hold the said Lands unto the said Alexander H Green and his heirs and assigns forever

In testimony whereof the members of said Board hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and here caused the seal of the Florida State Land Office who hereunto affixed at the Capitol in the City of Tallahassee on this the thirteenth day of January AD Eighteen hundred and Eighty Eight
