and in Consideration of the sum of two
hundred thirty five \$100 (235⁰⁰) Dollars paid and secured when paid
by Willis Orange to the Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company a
Corporation chartered by the state of Florida the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged the said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company has
granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain
sell and convey unto said Willis Orange all the following tracts
or parcels of land situate in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida
and described as follows to wit: The Lots numbered two & three (2 & 3)
in Section thirty six (36) in Township two (2) north of Range twenty eight
(28) West - Containing one hundred fifty six \$100 (156⁰⁰) acres more or less
Whome and whose unto the said Willis Orange his heirs & assigns and
assigns forever. Now therefore in Consideration of the premises the
said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company hereby warrants and
defends the title in and to the above granted premises to the said Willis
Orange in fee simple forever and in pursuance of the third Section
in the Mortgage executed by the said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad
Company to Edmund D Randolph and John L Cochwalader as
trustees dated 1st April 1884 duly acknowledged and recorded the said
Randolph and Cochwalader hereby convey all their interest as said
Trustees in said land to the said Willis Orange - this deed being
as to them a quit claim as trustees and without warranty of title
by them
