and by these presents do give grant bargain sell & convey  
unto the said Geo. A. Greay his heirs & assigns the following  
real estate lying & being situate in the State of Nevada County  
of Clark & within the corporate limits of the Town of Hamilton  
known and described as follows to wit: half acre of land bounded  
north by Williams Hamilton East by Tom Moorey lot south by  
land owned by Hamilton West by Pine Street in Lot No. Four  
East Township one Range twenty eight belonging to the said  
Oscar Pagan, and being a lot of real estate purchased by him  
of the Estate of Alexander Early and & deeded to said Pagan by  
Caryanne Fern & R. Sheppard Commission appointed to sell  
said land by Hon. Jas. Chalmers Judge of the County Court of said  
County said deed of Caryanne being date March 19<sup>th</sup> 1888, being
