



Now all men by their present that
the Board of Education of Florida under
an act of the Legislature of the State of
Florida entitled an act to establish a
uniform system of common school
and a university approved January
30, 1869 and the present Constitution of
said State for and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar and twenty five
cents per acre to them in hand paid
by Lewis P. Golson, William C. Golson
and Neil C. McMillan of the County
of Santa Rosa, State of Florida have
granted bargained and sold and do by
their presents grant bargain sell and
convey unto the said Lewis P. Golson, William
C. Golson & Neil C. McMillan and their
heirs and assigns forever the following
described Land to wit:

The South East quarter of the north west quarter
of Section Sixteen in Township one north
of Range Twenty eighth West containing
thirty nine & ⁹⁴/₁₀₀ acres and lying
and being in the County of Santa Rosa
in said State of Florida. to have and
to hold the said land unto the said
Lewis P. Golson, William C. Golson and Neil C. McMillan
and their heirs and assigns forever
In testimony whereof the members of said
Board have hereunto subscribed their names
and affixed their seals and have caused
the Seal of the Florida State Land Office to be
hereunto affixed at the Capitol in the City of
Tallahassee on this the thirteenth day of
October A.D. (1887) Eighteen hundred and eighty
seven
