

Contract
between
Farrar Cobb &
and
John Sullivan

This agreement entered into this the 9th day of Oct. 1888 between Farrar Cobb & John Sullivan both of the county of Santa Rosa Florida. Witness: that where as said Sullivan & Cobb are partners in business doing business under firm name of Sullivan & Cobb of said state & county. Now then that they have this day mutually agreed to dissolve said partnership: said Cobb to succeed said Sullivan & Cobb in said partnership business and said Sullivan withdrawing there from. said partnership being dissolved on terms as follows. To wit: Said Cobb to pay unto said Sullivan for his entire interest what so ever in said business including stock on hand in this mercantile business all property owned by them in this business of logging of any & all kind what so ever. and all assets of any & all kind what so ever appertaining to said business including debts & demands against any & all persons (whomsoever) chosen in assets & etc: the sum of \$250⁰⁰ in Cash and the sum of \$490⁰⁰ to be paid within ten months from date in legal monthly installments. (It being agreed upon & understood that the store or mercantile acct owing by said Sullivan to said Sullivan & Cobb known as his individual store acct (to date July 1st 1888) is to be cancelled and such property belonging to said partnership now at his residence - premises of said Sullivan to wit: One Organ one Single Buggy and one double buggy to remain to said Sullivan as his property) It being further more understood and agreed as a condition hereto that said Cobb shall procure one S.T. Margoni as a guarantor that said monthly payments shall be paid by said Cobb it being further more agreed & understood as to said amount to be paid that no interest shall be charged thereon. And the said Cobb agrees to assume until due if not paid when due the interest to be paid. All liabilities of any & all kind whatsoever against said partnership. And said Sullivan agrees to said dissolution of partnership on foregoing terms mentioned. All of which is hereby mutually agreed to between
